Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission to Chaudhary Harchand Singh Atmaram Education Trust, Quadra Institute of Ayurveda, NH-58, Haridwar Road, Roorkee-247667, Uttarakhand (AYU0320) with intake capacity of 51 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) course and 21 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Shalya tantra-05 seats, (iii) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta-05 seats and (iv) Rachna Sharir-05 seats for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Chaudhary Harchand Singh Atmaram Education Trust, Quadra Institute of Ayurveda, NH-58, Haridwar Road, Roorkee-247667, Uttarakhand (AYU0320)** inspection was conducted on **25.05.2026 and 26.05.2026 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process for issuance of permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024 provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020. **On careful examination of the assessment report the shortcomings/defects were observed** and the same was placed in the **165th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **24.07.2026**. Board discussed and decided to seek Clarification from the college regarding the shortcomings observed during the assessment.
- 3) Further, in adherence to the principles of natural justice, an opportunity of clarification vide letter even no. dated 03.08.2026 was provided to you. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref. no. QIA/QA-305/2026/740 dated 05.08.2026.
- 4) The clarification report was placed in the **172th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 18.08.2026 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024 and regulation 15 (7) of MESAR PG Ayurveda regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and as per the Punitive Policy for the Academic session 2026-27

❖ **As per the "Punitive Policy for the academic session 2026-27" :-**

- i) "For each deficient teaching faculty, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 5% of total intake capacity."

There is shortcoming of 1LF in the department of Prasuti & Stri Roga, 1LF in the department of Kaumarbhritya -Bala Roga and 1LF in the department of Shalakya Tantra respectively.

There is deficiency of total 03 teaching faculties, therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 15% of total intake capacity (i.e. Reduction of 09 seats).

Accordingly, after applying the punitive policy for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **yearly permission with intake capacity of 51 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**

"DECISION"

- 5) Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Chaudhary Harchand Singh Atmaram Education Trust, Quadra Institute of Ayurveda, NH-58, Haridwar Road, Roorkee-247667, Uttarakhand (AYU0320) with 51 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda

regulations, 2024 and 21 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats and (ii) Shalya tantra-05 seats , (iii) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta-05 seats and (iv) Rachna Sharir-05 in accordance with regulation 15 (7) of MESAR PG Ayurveda regulations, 2024 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

- 6) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) **Compliance report of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 issued by the board.**
- 9) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-28 :-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.
- 11) Further, in case you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal addressed to the Chairman, NCISM, as per regulation 65(1) of MESAR 2024.

Note:-It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
